The College is under the administrative supervision of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, who reports to the University President. The College consists of three academic departments (Accounting, Business Law, and Finance; Decision Sciences and Economics; and Management and Marketing) and two Centers (The South Texas Economic Development Center (STEDC); and The Coastal Bend Business Innovation Center).

The College is headed by the Dean, who supervises six administrative positions: the Associate Dean, the Director of Master's Programs, the Project Manager, The IT Manager, the Program Coordinator, and the Business Coordinator.

The Dean also serves as the Director of the Coastal Bend Business Innovation Center. The Chairs of the Academic Departments (Accounting, Business Law, and Finance; Decision Sciences and Economics; and Management and Marketing) and the Chair of The South Texas Economic Development Center (STEDC) report to the Dean.

The Academic Advisors report to the University Director of Academic Advising, but are supervised by the College Associate Dean in interpreting certain course requirement substitutions or exceptions requested by undergraduate students and in interpreting AACSB accreditation guidelines related to degree requirements.
